# **DHL-1 INSTRUCTIONS**

## 1. CONNECT BATTERY


Open the cover and snap the battery into the battery clip. Replace cover. On units powered by AC adapter, plug in the power jack.




#### 2. CONNECT TUBING

The JACO compression fitting will work on hard or soft tubing. Install as follows:

- •Cut tubing squarely. (Remove burrs if hard tubing)
- •Insert tubing through the nut all the way to the back.
- •Turn the nut hand tight.





If it is necessary to replace the fitting with a different size, screw the replacement teflon-taped fitting only one turn past hand tight.

## 3. BATTERY REMINDER

Put a reminder on your PM program to replace the battery according to this chart. As a guide, a single battery will provide 50 hours of continuous alarming and has a shelf life of 10 years.

ALARM FREQUENCY	REPLACEMENT TIME
Several times daily	Yearly
Once a day	two years
Weekly	4 years
Monthly	6 years
Never	10 years

The bottom screen is removable for inspection of the float.
